Commercial Winery Category

To be entered into the Commercial Winery category the wine must be part of a lot of identical wine of at least 125 cases (300 gallons) of finished wine. In addition, a minimum of 100 cases (240 gallons) must be available for sale to the public either at the winery or through normal licensed distribution channels.

Micro Winery Category

The Micro Winery Category allowed tasting of wines from an increasing number of small or micro wineries in California whose wines are likely to reach the general market because of the limited supply. Wineries entering this category were required to produce a minimum of 125 total cases of wine (300 gallons) and not more than 2,526 cases (6,000 gallons) per season. Specific wines entered in this category could exceed a production of 1,052 cases.

Double Gold

The Double Gold award is reserved for those wines judged superior to others in their class by receiving a unanimous vote for Gold award by a panel of judges.

Best of Class of Region

The Best of Class of Region is the highest scoring varietal from a specific region or appellation.
